2. What is the issue you would like the board to address and why? Allow use of cellular game/trail cameras. This tool would be advantageous to hunters, in particular bear baiters. They do not allow hunters to cheat, kill more game, or whatever other misnomer is out there. In the case of bear baiting, the fair chase argument is null and void. That is a tool used to selectively harvest bears, not based on what is "fair or sporting". Cell cameras can save hunters hundreds of dollars in gas in the early season. They would allow children to see bears from home that may not be ready to hunt or are on the fence about participating. These cameras cannot kill animals for you. They can however notify you if you have an unwanted guest in real time. There is no actual downside to their use. Bag limits will remain the same, bears will still come and go as they please.

3. What solution do you recommend? In other words, if the board adopted your solution, what would the new regulation say? (Please provide draft regulatory language, if possible.)

In all of unit 20 cellular cameras maybe used during bear baiting seasons.
