2. What is the issue you would like the board to address and why? Adjust the season opener of the forty mile RC860 hunt to July 31st. State managers should not be deferring to federal managers by allowing federal harvest before state allocation. That would be in conflict of article 8 of the state constitution and falls out of line from section E of the statehood act where the state was given sole management of its wildlife by the same federal government. I would encourage managers to support all Alaskan's opportunities.
