Changes to the IFQ:

Change 1: Recognize the removal of the Scope of Work, Section 2: CONTAINERS bullet point in its entirety and replace it with the following update:

CONTAINERS

DPS requests two 20' conex containers, that are either green or brown, if possible, to help blend into the surroundings. Ensure the containers are on level ground, on a solid gravel pad. Containers must be elevated to ensure the doors can open during winter months, preferably on railroad ties or equivalent. No ramp is required as part of this solicitation. Bidders shall provide a quote for standard conex doors on the front and may also provide a quote for manual garage-type doors for the front of each conex and man doors on each conex to provide access into the covered storage area.

Change 2: Recognize that bidders are required to use the updated Quote Submittal Form to provide quotes. Bidders have the option to provide a bid for Option One, Option Two, or both Option One and Option Two. Bidders shall insert a fixed price for each line item within the option(s) you select to bid on. Options that do not have a fixed price for each line item shall not be considered for purposes of award. The State shall award at its discretion for either Option One or Option Two, to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, based on budget allowance by the State.
