Site 2: Between two ponds along Akoswift Creek

Site 3: Between Milk Creek and Cascade Lake

**REQUESTED ACTIVITY:** The applicant, David Humphrey, has requested a 10-year Trapping Cabin Permit for the construction and use of three trapping cabins along their established trapline, to be used in conjunction with seasonal trapping activities (November-March).

Site 1 near Kisaralik Lake: up to 400 square feet

Site 2 near Akoswift Creek: up to 192 square feet

Site 3 near Cascade Lake: up to 192 square feet

**PROPOSED DATES OF USE:**

Start: July 1, 2026

End: June 30, 2036
