Notice is given that the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF), under authority vested by AS 2.15.020 and Title 17 AAC 42.125, intends to modify certain fees listed below for the Alaska International Airports System (AIAS), consisting of the Ted Stevens Anchorage (ANC) and Fairbanks (FAI) International Airports. The proposed rates will become effective **July 1, 2026**, for AIAS users. The proposed rates are as follows and are subject to change by further public notice at any time:
