- 2) **Change 2: Section 3.01 Scope of Work, on page 13, 1, a), viii-** This section has been updated to read: No-cost NRT patches, gum, and lozenges offered or upon request to eligible participants who enroll in Alaska's Tobacco Quit Line, regardless of counselling program participation.
- 3) **Change 3: Section 4.06 Methodology Used for the Project (Submittal Form D) 2. Service Protocol, i, xiv-xvii** – This section has been updated to read:
 - xiv. Protocols that will be used to ensure TPC program review when the vendor is considering new products, technology, or methods of service delivery. Please include examples of how this protocol is currently used or how it will be used to ensure alignment with the contract and TPC program approval.
 - xv. Protocol which will ensure timely service delivery based upon the estimated calls/sessions in Attachment 03 Submittal Form H. Please address estimated calls by a monthly amount.
 - xvi. Protocol to streamline intake and enrollment processes to reduce barriers to enrollment and maximize sessions with enrollees.
 - xvii. Description of how the vendor will supply adequate NRT in a timely manner based upon the estimated enrollments and Alaska's unique geography and mail carrier systems.
