Question submitted by potential offerors and answer from the State:

Question 1 of 1:

In Amendment No. 2 it asks for the Project Manager's (PM) resume to be included in the proposal. Would you like the PM's resume to be included in Submittal Form B - Experience and Qualifications? If yes, will the resume count toward the total page count limit (5 pages) stated in the original IRFP for Form B?

If you would like the PM's resume included in another section of the proposal, can you please confirm where and if it will count toward the page length?

Answer 1 of 1:

The primary PM's resume is a requirement of IRFP Section 4.04 - Experience and Qualifications (Submittal Form B). As such, it may be placed after Submittal Form B. However, it is also acceptable to simply add the resume at the end, following Submittal Form F. Whether placed immediately following Submittal Form B or at the end of all submittal forms, the primary PM's resume will *not* count toward the total page limitation for Submittal Form B and must not include any marketing or proposal verbiage. The following statement has been added to the IRFP, Section 4.04: "This resume will not count toward the page limitation for Submittal Form B."

Update to the IRFP:

Change 1 of 1: The following section is updated:

In IRFP – SECTION 4.01 – IRFP SUBMITTAL FORMS, replace the following passage:

Unless otherwise specified in this IRFP, the Submittal Forms shall be the offeror's entire proposal. Do not include any marketing information in the proposal.

with the following:

Unless otherwise specified in this IRFP, the Submittal Forms shall be the offeror's entire proposal. Do not include any links or marketing information in the proposal or it will be removed by the procurement officer prior to the proposals being sent to the proposal evaluation committee (PEC).
