| EXPLANATION |
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The Alaska Railroad Corporation is cancelling ITB 26-18-214518– ARRC SEWARD FREIGHT DOCK EXPANSION and rejecting all bids. This decision is based on the following criteria contained in:

Federal Acquisition Regulations:

FAR 14.404-1(c) Allowing the rejection of all bids where specifications are inadequate or ambiguous

State Procurement Regulations

Title AS 36.30.350(c) & 2 AAC 12.860:

(4) prices exceed available money;

(5) all otherwise acceptable bids or proposals received are at unacceptable prices;

(7) the award is not in the best interest of the Alaska Railroad Corporation.

This ITB is canceled without award of a contract. The Alaska Railroad Corporation intends to work with its design engineer to review and revise the project requirements and specifications prior to re-solicitation. Upon completion of this review, ARRC may issue a new competitive solicitation or, if determined appropriate and in accordance with ARRC Procurement Rules, may conduct a Limited Solicitation under Procurement Rule 1400.2. ARRC reserves the right to select the procurement method determined to be in its best interest and consistent with applicable procurement requirements

If ARRC elects to proceed with a Limited Solicitation, the firms invited to participate may include Granite Construction Company and Duwamish Services LLC, among any other firms ARRC determines are qualified and appropriate for the procurement.
