The following are vendor questions and the department's response:

1. Vendor: With the lack of drawings for representation of existing installation, do you have any pictures of the existing installations for reference? I appreciate any information you can provide. This will assist us in determining existing site conditions as well as mechanical and electrical connections.

We have the generators we plan to propose using. But it really comes down to connections to existing infrastructure, where the boundary of scope is as far as how far in to a system are we responsible for, and what are the existing site conditions.

2. Vendor: There are requirements for shop drawings and record drawings referenced in the spec. Is the intent for the record drawings to be a stamped set of drawings that we provide? Are there any asbuilt drawings available for these sites that we can reference?
