INSTRUCTIONS

This form is an application for successive renewal of a valid, existing permit to conduct surface or underground mining and reclamation activities or other surface coal mining and reclamation operations in Alaska pursuant to AS 27.21.080. The right of successive renewal applies only to lands and activity which were permitted during the previous term. Type or print clearly the appropriate information. Supplemental sheets may be used as necessary to respond to each section. Supplemental sheets must be attached to the form and referenced or keyed to the numbers on the form.

- Part A** Part A1 and A2 provide the name of the operation, and all permits associated with the operation that are being renewed. Part A4 and A5 provide the name and business contact information for the Applicant/Operator. Part A6 Provide the name phone number and email of the person authorized to sign the application and accept service on behalf of the applicant/operator. Part A7 Provide the name phone number and email of the person responsible for administering the permit. Part A8 and A9 Provide contact information for the operator if someone other than the applicant is conducting the mining operations. Part A10 Enter the requested permit renewal term (up to 5 years). Part A11 and A12 Provide the reclamation bond amount at the end of the current permit term and a proposed bond amount for the next permit term. Under 11 AAC 90.205 DNR will consider this proposed bond amount when determining the reclamation bond for the next permit term. Part A15 Provide an estimate of the remaining life of active mining operations (including facility operations).
- Part B** Provide general location information for the mining operations. If needed for Part B1 attach additional pages to provide a complete legal description.
- Part C** For Part C1 through C7 provide updated information that reflects mining and reclamation operations for the next permit term or the conditions at the close of the current permit term. If any of items in Part C1 through C7 do not need to be updated provide the date of the last revision in the permit and an explanation in Part C8 as to why the item does not need to be updated.
- Part D** In addition to the information required to be submitted under Part C, an applicant may submit revisions to the approved operations and reclamation plan as part of the renewal application. These additional revisions will be processed and approved separately unless the Department finds a compelling reason to include them as part of the renewal.
