Questions & Answers:

Question 1: What is the typical timeline for a new offeror to complete the 7 AAC 70.140 department approval process, including establishing the MOA or similar data reporting arrangement with DOC?

Answer: *The 7 AAC 70.030 department approval process is conducted by the Department of Health, Division of Behavioral Health, and any questions related to the timeline or procedure should be directed to their office. The 7 AAC 70.140 data reporting requirements for DOC are arranged through the contract as outlined in Sec. 3.06 of the RFP.*

Question 2: Can that process begin during the proposal period, or only after contract award? If it can begin now, who should an offeror be in contact with to initiate it, DOH DBH, DOC, or both?

Answer: *The 7 AAC 70.030 department approval process can begin now and will be through the Department of Health, Division of Behavioral Health. Therefore, contact to initiate that process should be directed to their office. DOC does not have a designated contact with DOH DBH.*
