Dear Commissioner Crowther,

Alyeska Pipeline Service Company (hereinafter "APSC"), the operator of the Trans Alaska Pipeline System (TAPS) and agent for ConocoPhillips Transportation Alaska Inc, ExxonMobil Pipeline Company LLC and Harvest Alaska LLC (collectively the "TAPS Owners") submit the following Application for renewal of the Right-of-Way Lease (Lease # 63574) for the Trans Alaska Pipeline System ("TAPS Lease") and other rights associated with the TAPS Lease ("Associated Rights"). The TAPS Lease was originally issued on January 3, 1974 and was first renewed on November 26, 2002.

The TAPS Lease provides that "[t]he Commissioner shall renew the Lease [and Associated Rights] . . . so long as the Pipeline is in commercial operation and the Lessees are in full compliance with State Law, including but not limited to State law pertaining to regulation and taxation of the Pipeline." TAPS Lease section 2(c).

The TAPS Owners own undivided interests in the State Lease and Associated Rights. Each TAPS Owner and its respective percentage interest in the Federal Grant and Associated Rights is as follows: ConocoPhillips Transportation Alaska Inc. 29.6102%, ExxonMobil Pipeline Company LLC 21.2829%, and Harvest Alaska LLC 49.1069%.

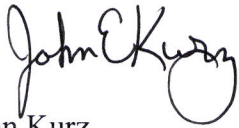
The renewed State Lease and Associated Rights will be owned in the percentages reflected above. The TAPS Owners respectfully request renewal of the Lease and Associated Rights for the maximum term authorized by applicable law, thirty years.

APSC has established a Right-of-Way Renewal Team to work with the State of Alaska Department of Natural Resources (DNR) in renewing the TAPS Owners' rights. They have been in discussion with your staff regarding additional information requirements the department may have and will be delivering
