REQUESTED ACTIVITY: Bristol Prime Contractors LLC is requesting construction of an ice road from Point Mackenzie across the Susitna Flats State Game Refuge (SFSGR). The ice

road will be constructed between January and March and will include an ice bridge across the Little Susitna River west from the end of West Ayrshire Avenue. The ice road is to facilitate 400ft of riverbank armoring along Chugach Electric Associations' transmission tower near the mouth of the Little Susitna River. Additional cross-country use of up to 10 vehicles that exceed Generally Allowed Use along the ice road is requested. This will result in material being extracted from the revetment site and purchased from state land at the regional representative sale price per cubic yard determined by the DNR Commissioner or at fair market value determined by appraisal. Bristol Prime Contractors will be applying for an easement to conduct revetment work. Their notice is not included in this notice.

Start: January 1, 2027

End: March 31, 2027

DEADLINE FOR COMMENTS: September 29, 2026

The public is invited to comment on this activity. The purpose of this notice is to gather input before a decision is made on this activity.
