On April 18, 2013 a written question was received in regards to the FY14 – FY17 Obesity Prevention and Control for K-12 Request for Proposals. Following is the written question received and the DHSS answer clarifying information in the RFP.

Q1: Does the 2011 YRBS data need to be attached?

A1: A full 2011 YRBS report is not a required attachment to this proposal. Please refer to the two RFP excerpts below for guidance on using local YRBS data in the proposal.

1.05 Target Population and Service area (p.10 of RFP)

The proposal should describe health risk factors of the target population such as percent of overweight or obese students. School districts that have successfully conducted a local Youth Risk Behavior Survey in the past four years should provide data based on survey results. Local data is preferred, however if the applicant does not have local data, tribal, regional or state data may be cited.

3B. Conduct a local Youth Risk Behavior Survey (p.9 of Attachment 1:Descriptions of Required Activities and Initiatives)

Proposal narrative must include plan for successful implementation of a local YRBS in spring 2015 and spring 2017 including gathering of parental permission forms. For YRBS data to be considered representative of the student population, 60% of high school students must complete the survey. If your district has participated in the past, please include response rate by percentage and number of surveys attained in previous years of YRBS implementation. If your district does not have an existing YRBS coordinator, the position description for the grant coordinator should indicate YRBS duties.
