OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME**


The attached one page of regulations, dealing with private nonprofit salmon hatchery permit application procedures, are adopted and certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Department of Fish and Game adopts under the authority of AS 16.05.020, AS 16.05.092, and AS 16.10.400 and after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.

In considering public comments, the Department of Fish and Game paid special attention to the cost to private persons of the regulatory action being taken.

The regulation changes adopted under this order take effect on the 30th day after they have been filed by the lieutenant governor, as provided in AS 44.62.180.



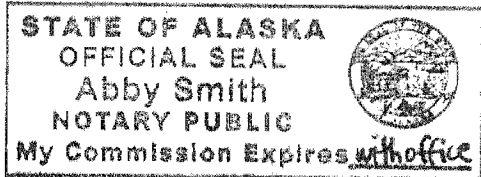

Title 5. Fish and Game.

Chapter 40. Private Nonprofit Salmon Hatcheries.

Article 4. Permit Application Procedures.

The lead-in language of 5 AAC 40.130(b) is amended to read:

(b) ⁽³⁾No later than 90 days after [WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER RECEIPT BY] the PNP coordinator receives from the applicant [OF] the information described in (a) of this section, the department will complete a management feasibility analysis of the proposed hatchery. A management feasibility analysis includes, at a minimum, the following information:
