REGULATIONS OF THE ALASKA BOARD OF FISHERIES**


The attached 20 pages of regulations, dealing with sport and commercial finfish and shellfish fisheries in the state are hereby certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Alaska Board of Fisheries adopted at its March 19–23, 2013 meeting in Anchorage, Alaska, under the authority of AS 16.05.251 and after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.

On the record, in considering public comments, the Alaska Board of Fisheries paid special attention to the cost to private persons of the regulatory action being taken.

The regulation changes described in this order take effect on the 30th day after they have been filed by the lieutenant governor, as provided in AS 44.62.180.



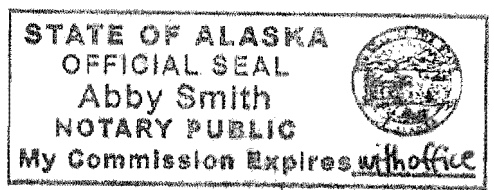
