- A. At the time the proposals are opened, all offerors must hold a valid Alaska business license and any necessary applicable professional licenses required by Alaska Statute. - Q. Is there any additional information you may supply regarding what a Conflict of interest (sec. 1.17) would be with the State of Alaska?
- A. A potential conflict of interest could be a current or prior relationship with a current employee or public official with the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development. Offerors must disclose actual and potential conflicts of interest for determination at the time proposals are opened.
