G. §2.08 has been changed (highlighting added below to illuminate the change):

“In order for offers to be considered responsive offerors must demonstrate the following:

- 1) Possession of or the ability to obtain at least one of the following Alaskan Teaching Certificates: Type A/Professional Teacher; Type B Administrative; or Retired (Lifetime).
- 2) At least 5 years of either classroom or administrative experience in Alaska; and
- 3) Experience as a member of a school or district leadership team.

An offeror's failure to meet these minimum prior experience requirements will cause their proposal to be considered non-responsive and their proposal will be rejected.”

H. Typos in §'s 5.10 and 5.11 have been corrected. The descriptions in each now start “Please provide a list...” instead of “Please list of...”

I. The heading of §5.07 has been corrected to “CONFLICT OF INTEREST.”

J. A “Preference Worksheet” has been uploaded to the Online Public Notice page for this RFP. This worksheet is to aid a potential offeror in identifying and claiming any preferences. If included with a proposal it should be attached between Attachment 07 and Attachment 08. If an offeror has already submitted a proposal and wishes to include the Preference Worksheet it may be faxed to (907) 465-3452; receipt of a faxed Preference Worksheet will be confirmed with either an email or phone call. An original must still be mailed to the procurement office at the addresses detailed in RFP §1.01.

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- K. The scores of the samples in RFP §6.02 and §6.04 did not add up from subsection to subsection and included sample language that did not apply to this RFP. This has been corrected.
- L. RFP §6.02 language on breaking any ties has been clarified.
- M. The following questions have been asked; the answers follow the questions. The numbering continues from Amendment 02 and thus starts at #3.

- **Question #9:**

I am about to get the required insurance. What evidence needs to be in the RFP?

Answer to Question #9:

The insurance requirements in §3.06 and Attachment 02 are for after award. The insurance does not need to be in place at the time proposals are opened. Failure to provide evidence of the required insurance after award will mean that award will be withdrawn to that offeror. The basic time is after award is announced, we wait ten days for any protests, then contracts are offered and evidence for the insurance is provided by the successful offerors.
