Kayak Island-Scope of Work: Debris Monitoring, Removal, and Disposal

The offeror must submit a cost proposal with a total cost for a sample project consisting of the removal and disposal of 400 cubic yards (weight approximately 4,000 pounds) of high-windage, inert, non-hazardous marine debris (e.g., plastic, buoys, and foam) from a ten-mile stretch of beach accessible by boat on the NE end of Kayak Island. The project is to be completed, assuming calm seas, between August 1, 2013 and August 31, 2013.

Cost Factors to consider (not all inclusive): personnel costs, wages, taxes, per diem, insurance, fuel costs, vessel lease and/or operational costs, equipment, shipping, recycling, disposal, and administrative costs and/or overhead.

This may or may not be a region that you have proposed or work within.
