Roll Call: Chair Crawford, Brandt, Carmichael, Hamrick, Maher, Erkeneff, Strieby, Joseph, Sullivan, Dykema, Shadura II, Van Devere.

Erkeneff asked for the reconsideration of proposal be brought back to the table. Chair Crawford explained that after reviewing Robert's Rules the reconsideration must be brought forward by the prevailing party; since Roberts was not in the prevailing party vote the reconsideration was not valid. Seeing that the prevailing parties are not in favor of reconsideration the original vote stands. Crawford also wanted Committee Members not present at the December 16, 2013 to have a chance to comment.

The following comments regarding 242:

Additional damage will be done to the habitat, it will make sport fishing difficult, there is a concern of safety for anglers on the bank and that they had just resolved the issue of going from a 2 stroke to 3 stroke motor due to the amount of hydrocarbons in the Kenai River.

Additional comment the Kenai River needed to be consider wholly and not was just on the surface.
