# ORDER RA 14-02 ADOPTING CHANGES TO REGULATIONS OF THE DIVISION OF INSURANCE

The attached 4 pages of regulations, dealing with clarification of the term "year of adoption" in AS 21.42.160 are hereby adopted and certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Division of Insurance adopts (3 AAC 31.200, 3 AAC 31.250, and 3 AAC 31.299) under the authority of AS 21.06.090; AS 21.42.120; AS 21.42.123; AS 21.42.125; AS 21.57.080; AS 21.66.450; AS 21.84.255; AS 21.86.070; AS 21.87.180; and AS 21.96.080. after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.

In considering public comments, the Division of Insurance paid special attention to the cost to private persons of the regulatory action being taken.

### 3 AAC 31.250(a) is amended to read:

(a) In addition to the requirements under 3 AAC 31.200 – 3 AAC 31.225, a form filing must include a unique form number on each form. Each form must also have printed on it the year of adoption of the form. The year of adoption appearing on the form is the year of the

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or approved by the director for use by the insurer in this state for the particular program, product, and line of business to which the filing applied, unless one of the following applies:

(1) if the year of the effective date of the filing in which the new, revised, or replacement form was authorized or approved by the director for use by the insurer in this state is different than the year of the effective date initially requested in that filing, and the effective date initially requested complies with AS 21.42.123(c), AS 21.42.125(b), or 3 AAC 29.525, the initially requested effective date may be considered the year of adoption of the forms in the filing;

(2) if a form has been previously authorized or approved by the director for use by the insurer in this state for another program or product or under another line of business and is not a revision to or replacement of a form currently authorized or approved for use in the particular program, product, and line of business to which the filing applies, the year of adoption of the previously authorized or approved form may be considered the form's year of adoption for the particular program, product, and line of business to which the filing applies;

(3) if a form has been previously authorized or approved by the director for use in this state by an insurer with the same National Association of Insurance

Commissioners' group number and is not a revision to or replacement of a form currently authorized or approved by the director for use by the insurer making the filing, the year of adoption of the previously authorized or approved form may be considered the form's year of adoption for the insurer making the filing;

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(4) if a form is used by the insurer in multiple states, is not a revision to or replacement of a form currently authorized or approved by the director for use in this state, and includes a year the form was adopted in another state or an edition date year, the year the form was adopted in another state or edition date year appearing on the multistate form may be considered the form's year of adoption in this state; or

(5) if a form has been filed by a licensed rating organization and has been authorized or approved by the director for use in this state, the year of adoption on the applicable rating organization form may be considered the form's year of adoption, but only if the form has not been modified and one of the following applies:

(A) the insurer is a member of, or subscriber to, the rating organization and has authorized the director to accept the form filings of the rating organization on the insurer's behalf, regardless of whether the insurer makes a filing with the director requesting an effective date for implementation of the rating organization filing that does not coincide with the effective date of the applicable rating organization filing; as

(B) the insurer makes a filing to adopt the form, without modification, by reference to the applicable rating organization form filing.
