- 1. **REVISE:** Spec section 061200, section 1.4 A to be deleted:
 - a. a. SIP Manufacture shall be a member of the Structural Insulated Panel Association (SIPA).
- 2. **QUESTION:** 260500 M. Remodel; Work references any remodel work, the building is new construction and the only work that is performed on existing structures is connecting a 2" conduit and wiring to the existing 400A panel located on the exterior of the forestry duplex building. Please clarify this section.

RESPONSE: Remodel work entails removal of an existing meter base and feeders, as well as utilizing an existing 400A panel

3. **QUESTION:** 262716 Service Entrance B&C; Work references A meter socket, a CT cabinet, and a 4" PVC conduit stub from transformer location. Question- Where is this referenced on the plans, according to the distribution 1 line, the building is being fed from the existing 400A panel located on the exterior of the forestry duplex building.

RESPONSE: All service entrance work pertaining to this project is shown in detail 3/E002 Electrical One-line Diagram. Specification sections 262716 B, C shall be omitted.

4. **QUESTION:** 270500 Tele –Data Communications F.4; References Combination voice/data wall Jack assembly with 3 angled CAT 6 and 3 Blanks. Sheet E001 shows 2 CAT 6 Jacks only. Please Clarify

RESPONSE: Each location shall receive 3 jacks/ cables.

 QUESTION: 270500 Tele –Data Communications G.2; References Vertical Backbone Cabling. Electrical Drawings show no copper backbone cabling. Please Clarify RESPONSE: Omit specification section 270500 G/2.

6. **QUESTION:** 270500 Tele –Data Communications G.3; References Fiber Optic Backbone Cabling. Electrical Drawings show no Fiber Optic backbone cabling. Please Clarify **RESPONSE:** Omit specification section 270500 G/3.

7. **QUESTION:** 270500 Tele –Data Communications I&K; Is Fiber available in the Facility? If not will these items still be required to be installed?

RESPONSE: These items are not required to be installed

8. **QUESTION:** Specification 270500.N.1 asks for a qualified NRTL, BICSI certified testing agency to perform tests and inspections on the communications system. Can the testing be performed by the contractor using BICSI certified personnel? **RESPONSE:** Yes.

9. **QUESTION:** Specification 270500 F.4 requires (3) Cat 6 jacks per voice/data outlet. The Legend on sheet E001 requires (2) Cat 6 jacks per telephone/data outlet. How many cable/jacks will be required per outlet?

RESPONSE: Three cables/jacks per outlet will be required.

QUESTION: Detail 1/E002 shows ENT conduit for voice/data. Specification 260533 B.3 doesn't allow for ENT on the project. Will ENT be allowed?
 RESPONSE: Yes, ENT is allowed for voice/data cabling only.

11. **QUESTION:** Electrical installation per the specifications is to be concealed EMT conduit in finished spaces. Exterior walls are non-furred out SIP panels. What is the intent for installing electrical in them? Can the EMT be surface mounted, or can MC cable be allowed to be installed in chases in the SIP panels?

RESPONSE: Surface mounted EMT is not allowed in occupied spaces. It is allowed above suspended ceilings and in mechanical and storage spaces. MC cable is allowed in the SIP panel chases.

DRAWINGS:

1. SHEET G101:

CHANGE: DOOR 107-2 located in TRAINING 107 to no longer serve as an emergency exit. Exit load directed out of doors 103-1 & 101-1.

2. SHEET A100

QUESTION: Can the anticipated finish floor elevation be provided for reference? **RESPONSE:** The anticipated finished floor level 100'-0" will be elevation 1280.5. Provide a 5% maximum grade at public entrance to door 101-1 and positive drainage (2% minimum) at the perimeter of the building.

3. SHEET A303:

CHANGE: Added clarity to rise and run dimension strings, confirm with existing grades. Detail 9/A303 Stair Section.

4. SHEET A901:

CHANGE: Exit sign deleted from above door 107-2. See Elec

5. SHEET E201

QUESTION: Note 9 on E201 shows a conduit going to the tele pedestal. Sheet E101 shows two telephone pedestals. Which pedestal does the 2" run to?

ANSWER: Note 9 requires coordination with the telephone service provider.

6. SHEET P100

QUESTION: Can the elevations of the existing sewer, sewer line, waterlines and other utilities be provided for bidding? Big difference in cost if these are in or out of anticipated excavation and backfill limits

RESPONSE: The existing sewer and water lines are capped in a culvert at or just below grade. Please see notes 7 and 10 on P100 and notes 7 and 9 on P200. Pre-bid site visit to be provided.




