A renewal reminder document will be mailed to each currently licensed athletic trainer at least 30 days before the renewal date. Failure to receive a renewal notice does not relieve a licensee from the responsibility of renewing a license on time.
 - (b) An applicant for renewal of an athletic trainer license shall
 - (1) complete the renewal application on a form provided by the department;
